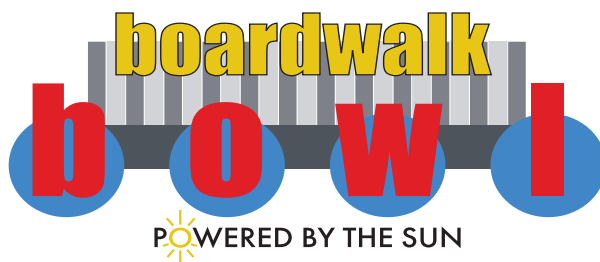


# YOUTH SUMMER CAMP

**First Day: Monday June 3, 2019 / Last Day: Friday August 9, 2019**

Welcome to the 2019 Youth Summer Camp! The following program is planned with a lot of safe and fun activities that will help build your child's intellectual, physical and social skills. Please note that there are a few rules to follow. All rules will be enforced to ensure the quality and safety of the program. Please read carefully, sign and return.

## **For Parent/Guardian:**

1. You must pay for your child to attend the Summer Camp. Payments are due each week (by Monday) your child attends. If a payment is missed and we need to use your deposit, your child may not return until the deposit and the current week is paid. We accept cash, checks, **(No Checks after July 19, 2019)** money orders, Master Card, Visa, Discover, & AMEX. We do have an ATM if needed available after 9:00am.
2. Every person picking up a child must "SIGN OUT" using the Summer Camp sign-out sheets. All persons authorized for pick up on the registration form must be able to produce a picture ID daily. The parent who signs the registration form may make changes to the authorized pick up list and student departure instructions in writing or by phone, provided a code word has been listed on the registration form. Anyone NOT listed on the registration form or authorized by phone followed up with a signed fax or email will NOT be allowed to pick up that child. The Summer Camp ends at 6:30p.m. There will be a \$5.00 late fee for every 5 minutes that you arrive past 6:30 p.m.
3. The above policies will be strictly enforced

**Drop of as early as 7:00a.m. Pick up by 6:30p.m.**

**Students will be separated by the grade they will be entering.**

When you register your child in the Summer Camp:

Two weeks minimum for registration plus registration fee.

\$40.00 registration fee per child

\$100.00 a week 1st child

\$100.00 a week 2nd child

\$95.00 a week each additional child

\$5.00 Late Fee for every 5 minutes after 6:30p.m per child

**Above Fee includes: Lunch provided for that day and an afternoon snack. (Students may bring lunch/snacks from home if they choose to not eat the lunch/snack provided that day. It is at the parent's discretion to check the lunch menu daily.) A substitute lunch will only be provided for known allergies listed on the registration packet.**

## **Daily Activities Included:**

Bowling / Outside playtime / Educational Crafts / Team building and cooperative skills and challenges.

## **Educational games that will include:**

Phonemic awareness and decoding skills / Vocabulary and comprehension skills / Writing opportunities

Students may bring extra money in an envelope to our office with their name and instructions on how much they can spend a day and for what use.

This is for: the arcade/pool tables / Extra snack from the vending machines / Grill

If students are dropped off early they may bring money to purchase toast, bagels, or an egg sandwich from the grill when it opens at 9:00a.m.

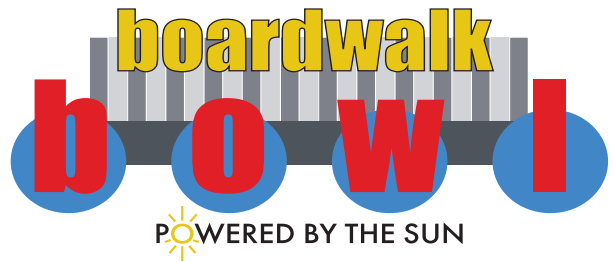

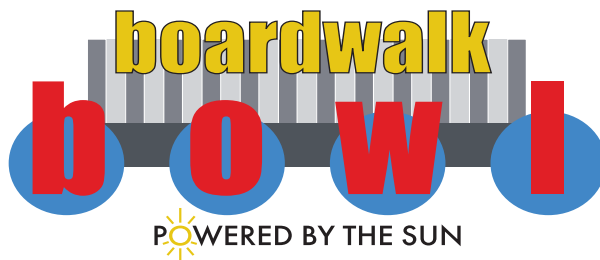

## Parent Contract

The following are Summer Camp policies that must be followed.

Please read the Parent Contract, initial each item and sign second page of the Parent Contract.

### Registration:

\_\_\_\_\_ \$40.00 registration fee plus a two-week's tuition will be required for each child enrolled in the program at time of registration. The two weeks' will be used to cover tuition for the first week and the last week that the child attends Summer Camp. If there are any changes to the weeks you originally picked, you must notify the Camp Director as WE DO NOT PROVIDE REFUNDS.

\_\_\_\_\_ After a returned check all payments must be done cash, credit card or money order.

You will be responsible for any extra fees.

\_\_\_\_\_ Two weeks minimum for registration

\_\_\_\_\_ Tuition is due each week by 6:30pm on Monday. Any tuition received after 6:30pm on Monday is considered late and will result in the deposit being applied as tuition. In order for the child to remain in the program, the deposit must be replaced along with tuition for the upcoming week. The "No Pay – No Stay policy will be strictly enforced. Habitual late payment may result in your child's dismissal from the program.

**Only credit card or cash payments will be accepted after July 19, 2019.**

\_\_\_\_\_ Tuition is a weekly fee. Tuition is not reduced when a child only attends a partial week. If a child does NOT attend at all for an entire week, (Monday-Friday) i.e. illness, vacation, etc., there will be NO tuition due for that week.

\_\_\_\_\_ Summer Camp tuition payments MUST be given to the Camp Director, or the Coordinator.

\_\_\_\_\_ Summer Camp policy states that children MUST be picked up by 6:30pm. Children may be dismissed from the program for repeated late pick up. A late pick-up fee is charged at a rate of \$5.00 (per child) for every 5 minutes after 6:30pm that the child is picked up. The late pick up fee must be included with your next tuition payment.

\_\_\_\_\_ Every person picking up a child must "SIGN OUT" in the front desk. All persons authorized for pickup on the registration form must be able to produce a picture I.D. The parent who signs the registration form may make changes to the authorized pick up list and student departure instructions in writing or by phone, provided a code word had been listed on the registration form. Anyone NOT listed on the registration form or authorized by phone will NOT be allowed to pick up that child.

### \_\_\_\_\_ You will forfeit all rights for Refunds.

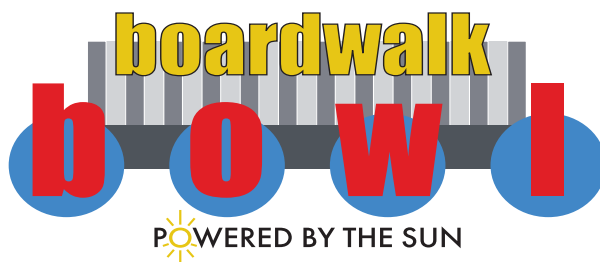
- If your child is released from the program for Behavioral Reasons with or without any medical conditions.
- If your child is released from the program at Parental Discretion
- If your child refuses to attend
- Inability to communicate to the Summer Camp Coordinator child's last week of attendance

The parent/guardian will be responsible to pay any bank fees for returned checks. Boardwalk Bowl Entertainment Center will no longer accept checks after one returned check. The bank fee and the amount of the insufficient fund check must be paid in cash before the next tuition payment is due.

## Summer Camp Program Policies For Parents and Students:

1. All children must follow Boardwalk Bowl Entertainment Center rules. We ask that they listen and respect their Summer Camp Leader. A child may be asked to leave the program if behavior becomes a problem with or without medical conditions. (Parents will be notified of each incident.)
  2. Fee includes: Lunch provided for that day and an afternoon snack.  
(Students may bring lunch/snacks from home or money if they choose to not eat the lunch/snack provided that day. It is at the parent's discretion to check the lunch menu daily) A substitute lunch will only be provided for known allergies listed on the registration packet.
  3. Please let us know of any allergies (food or other) below.
- 
4. Please put your child's name on their belongings (toys, clothing, blankets, game boys, games, iPods.) Advise your children if they let their friends borrow their belongings they are responsible to get them back. Boardwalk Bowl Entertainment Center is not responsible for any lost items or damaged belongings.
  5. No Cell Phones or Electronics are to be on during Camp Hours. They must use the phone in the Camp Directors Office.
  6. Your child may bring money to purchase arcade game cards. Our arcade uses play cards not tokens. Credits can be added to each card in \$1.00 increments. We can hold the money/cards for your child and limit the amount used. Send their money in an envelope with the child's name and instructions. Boardwalk Bowl is not responsible if your child has money in their possession.
  7. Due to many students having food allergies, students will not be allowed to share food/beverages
  8. Dress Code: Please use school dress codes policy and sneakers daily

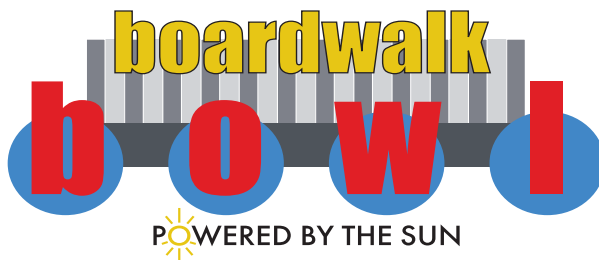

## Field Trips Admission / Bus Transportation

Boardwalk Bowl Summer Camp will provide transportation and pay for Transportation to and from all Field Trips.
